Game Administration And Debriefing Suggestions

- Ideal if played between 2 teams, each team can be 2 or more people. If there are not enough people, it can be played with one on one.
- When playing against each other, time is automatically controlled. If one of the teams finishes all envelopes, the other teams would be asked to stop too.
- The stereotype part is much more subtle in this version, so it is recommended to not tell the players about it in the beginning.
- During the debriefing session, it should be made clear to the players that guessing based on stereotypes could be misleading. The point of the game is to show them they inherently make judgements based on stereotypes.
- After scoring, the players can open the remaining envelopes to see where they went wrong.

Specific Feedback Requested

- What were the guesses for each round
- In the discussion, what were the points where players were misled (this in some cases is intentional..to show that they need to think beyond obvious facts)
- How many clues did players need on an avg to guess the answer
- A complete video of the game play would be extremely useful
